

RWI phonics

- Within all books children will have red and green words to help them to become speedy readers.
- Red words are words that are not easily sounded out and children have to learn them
- Green words are linked to the sounds they have been learning and are easily sounded out.
- Dots and dashes represent the sound each letter makes
- The children are encouraged to 'spot the sound' before 'Fred talking' the sounds within the words

What is the phonics screener?

- The purpose of the screener is to confirm that all children have learned phonic decoding to an age appropriate standard
- The phonic screener only tests their ability to read singular words
- It is a check containing 40 words. Section 1 contains around 12 'alien' words and 8 real words. Section 2 contains around 8 'alien' words and 12 real words
- The screener will take place throughout a week in June
- You will receive the results of the screener with the end of year report
- The children will have taken part in 3 practice screeners to allow them to become familiar with the process.
