


Year 6—Summer Term 2025

What's it all about?

This topic is a continuation from last half term and will continue to look at the human body. We will focus on the changes that will take place in the children's bodies during puberty. You should already have received information about the RSE curriculum and its coverage.







Readers: We will continue reading and exploring our core text 'The Hobbit' by JRR Tolkien, a wondrous tale of adventure and heroism in the fantasy realm of middle-earth.

Mathematicians: This half term we will be focusing on maths investigations where children will need to apply the mathematical skills they have built up this year to solve a variety of problems. We will look at investigational skills such as logical reasoning, pattern identification, drawing diagrams, acting a problem out and using concrete materials to solve a wide variety of investigations.

Science/Life Skills: We will begin by thinking about how we gain more independence as we get older. We will explore different types of relationships and look at how they might change as we grow older. We will be looking at what a healthy/unhealthy relationship looks like. We will then start our work on puberty and how babies are made. We will conclude by looking at body image.

Geographers: We will be continuing with our topic on the world to explore the concept of settlement. We will be looking at push and pull factors involved in migration and try to understand why someone may become a refugee.

Athletes: We will be working on a range of track and field sports.

Musicians: We will be learning, singing and performing songs from Matilda, our production.

Drama: This half term will be dedicated to performance, starting with our end of year production Matilda and finishing with our final leavers' assembly.
