
- 44 sounds

One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.




Speed Sounds Set 1, 2 and 3







How do I use the Virtual Classroom?

- 1. Find the virtual links via Tapestry
- 2. Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child each day.
- 3. Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet.
- 4. Praise your child as they join in with the lesson make it fun!

The more they practise using these films, the quicker they'll learn to read.



What can I do?

- 1. Use pure sounds rather than letter names.
- 2. Use Fred Talk to help your child to read and spell words.
- 3. Listen to your child read their Storybook every day.

- 5. Read stories to your child every day.
