My child is happy at school.	43	34	2	0	0	97% agreement . We are delighted by this outcome. Ensuring our pupils are happy and enjoy school is a priority for us.
My child feels safe at school. 79	45	30	3	0	1	95% agreement. A very positive response, again a priority for our school.
The school makes sure pupils are well behaved.	21	46	6	0	6	85% agreement and a further 8% who are unsure. At The Oaktree we teach children right from wrong through British values. We have an inclusive ethos where most children are aware of the behaviour expectations, our values and how to follow The Oaktree Way. The Oaktree support all children and Individual Behaviour Plans are written for those who need additional support.
My child has been bullied and the school have dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively 30/79	4	2	6	3	15	87% positive or have not experienced. 49 responded- My child has not been bullied We have a zero tolerance to bullying and where we are informed about incidents, we act swiftly to prevent further reproductions. For the 30% of parents who feel the school have not acted upon the bullying quickly or effectively, we hope to work with you and your child to improve outcomes. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.	12	55	6	2	4	86% agreement. We hope you find our newsletters and website informative. They provide details on what each year group are learning throughout the academic year. Topic grids are added to Seesaw and our websites termly. Please do take a look.
When I have raised concerns with the school they have dealt with it properly	12	30	8	1	2	79% agreement (of the 53 who expressed they had concerns). 26 responded that they have not raised concerns. If you are unhappy with a way your concerns are dealt with, please contact me directly.
My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to succeed 78	3	5	1	1	7	88% agreement from the 17 parents. 61 responded with my child does not have SEND. We are delighted with this response and the staff work hard to ensure that all children's needs are being met. If you are dissatisfied or unsure how your child is being support please do contact our SENCo.
The school has high expectations for my child 78	17	43	7	3	8	77% agreement The staff at The Oaktree School have worked hard this year constantly striving to enable children to meet end of year age related expectations, whilst filling holes and rectifying misconceptions as a result of the disruption to education. My child does well at school 78	28	46	3	0	1	82% agreement We are delighted that so many of you agree your child is doing well. The pandemic affected many children and we are delighted with how they have settled back into routines and are developing, emotionally, socially, physically and mentally.

We hope our termly parent's evenings and open the book events along with communication in reading records and face-to-face talks help enlighten you. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school 78	20	50	2	0	6	97% agreement including the 8% with no experience. Thank you! We strive to bring a broad and balanced curriculum to all children and our new topics are full of rich exciting experiences.
My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school	22	42	6	1	7	70% agreement. Reception children are offered clubs from the spring term onwards. This allows them time to settle into school. Covid forced us back into aged bubbles this year and limited the clubs on offer. We hope to offer more from the summer term onwards.

Afterall happy children learn best. We highly recommend the 15% of parents who are unaware of how we support children's personal development view the website which details this.
