2021 Pupil Questionnaire Results

In July 2021 we sent out a pupil questionnaire to find out how the children feel about their learning, their curriculum and discover what they enjoy most about school. All the results have been collated and are shown below. We are really pleased with the number of children enjoying school, enjoying their learning and the high number of pupils who feel safe when they are at school.

Teacher, Counters, ask someone, friends, 100 squares, maths area, spelling mats and houses, counting in head, using fingers, counters, dictionaries, objects, Fred fingers, teacher, tens and units, examples, using different strategies, grown up's, wall, start again, bear breathing, the office, tricky words, listening to others.				
5. My teachers give me work that challenges me.	93	86	90	90%	Too easy, I know a lot! Needs to be harder, I can do it, I practiced at home, It's not challenging, I'm an expert! could be harder, can be both tricky and easy,
6. Teachers and other staff listen to what I have to say.	100	95	97	97%	Because they have to say things. (They cannot listen when they are talking). There are some who don't teach me.
7. I feel safe when I am at school.	100	98	100	99%	Because its too loud.
8. There is an adult at school that I can talk to if something is worrying me.	100	97	99	99%	I don't have confidence to. I don't like talking to people when I'm worried. I can't find them.
9. The behaviour of other children in my lessons is good	99	73	81	84%	Because they're not very nice, lots shout at me, too chatty, they shout out, they talk about other stuff, very chatty, I don't like the noise, the noise distracts me, some talk when they shouldn't.
10. The behaviour of other children around the school is good.	99	82	96	92%	They're not nice, they stop us from working, it can be very loud, sometimes they come out of their bubble, Sometimes they get told off.



11. Is bullying a problem at school?	No - 95	No - 75	No - 67	No – 79%	Its mean, it hurts, others think its okay to hit and kick, its rude, it makes people sad, it's a bad thing to do, its unkind, it can hurt, it makes people cry, it is naughty, not sure.
12. I feel safe when I am at school	100	100	99	100%	No comments
13. My school encourages me to look after my physical health (eg: healthy eating and fitness)	100	99	99	99%	Not sure, I don't like the food.
14. My school encourages me to look after my emotions and talk about my feelings.	100	100	100	100%	No comments.
15. My schools encourages me to be independent and take on responsibilities	100	100	100	100%	No comments.
16. My school encourages me to respect people from other background and to treat everyone equally	100	100	100	100%	No comments.
17. I would recommend this school to a friend moving into the area.	100	100	100	100%	No comments.

Our next steps to improve outcomes for children are to improve our children's growth mindset. This will enable them to believe in their own abilities and see failure as part of the steps towards success. We also need to ensure work is consistently challenging for all children as some find it too easy. The main concerns about children's behaviour within The Oaktree School centre around too much talking or being too chatty! The staff will work with the children on this to ensure that noise is kept to a reasonable level and does not disturb others. It is clear from the bullying response and comments made, that the children have not all read this question and responded linked to behaviours seen at The Oaktree. They are all in agreement that Bullying is not nice and is not okay but we will need to rephrase this question next time to ensure we understand if they think it is happening at this school.
