# **Uniform Policy**

Please may we ask that no jewellery, including earrings, are worn to school. Our uniform policy states.

'On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The only exception is for Year 2 children to wear an analogue watch to aid them with learning to tell the time.'

Your child will be unable to take part in any physical activity, which includes PE and break times if earrings are worn.

Please may we also highlight the policy in regards to footwear -

'The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We expect all children to come to school in safe, sensible footwear that they can put on and take off independently.

#### What is allowed:

- plain black shoes
- black leather or leather-looking shoes
- black patent shoes
- shoe fastenings that have Velcro or buckle.

### What is not allowed:

- slip-on shoes
- platform soles or high heels
- boots (anything that covers the ankle)
- trainers are not school shoes, these are only for PE lessons
- shoes or trainers should not have flashing lights so as not to distract other children

Children should not be wearing shoes with shoe laces, unless they are able to put these on and take them off independently.

We further request that your attention is drawn to the below -

- Compulsory uniform items are available from Valentino's in Knaphill
  - School sweatshirts/school cardigans
  - Navy blue PE shorts
  - School book bag

Please could all children bring in a school book bag and not a rucksack. We do not have space in our class rooms to store large bags.
